In reference to information received during the early part of March concerning pay offs to First District policemen, it was pointed out that syndicate strip joints were being assessed \$300.00 a month. It has since been learned from CG 6443-C that this sum has been raised to \$1,000 per month from each club. This information would appear to corroborate the feeling of the Chicago Division that gambling operations are down within the First District. On the basis of a \$1,000 assessment from each club the total take for the month of January would have been \$9,000. Subtracting the \$4330.00 pay off to First District police for protection this would still leave approximately \$4700.00 for splitting among syndicate leaders as well as miscellaneous expenditures. It is assumed that of this amount in all probability approximately \$4,000 would be passed on from MARCY to an individual probably either GUS ALEX or FRANK FERRARO. From past information obtained a further split would be made of probably 50-50 between the FERRARO-ALEX organization and GIANCANA.
