Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies of a letterhead memorandum concerning captioned subject. CV T-1 is [redacted] Treasurer, Rand Development Corporation.

On 3/22/60, Mr. [redacted] provided an autostatic copy of the letter of C. E. WEBSTER, dated 3/19/60, addressed to Mr. H. J. RAND. He also provided the transcript of a 12 noon broadcast on Cleveland Radio Station KYW concerning the subject and his desire to return to the United States as embodied in his letter to his parents requesting their aid in effecting his return.

Mr. [redacted] at this time stated that Mr. RAND in the near future plans to return to Moscow, Russia, for the ostensible purpose of liquidating the Rand Development Corporation operation there; however, primarily he will be going there to cement relations with certain business contacts which he developed pursuant to his operation with the U.S. Air Force.

[redacted] stated that on receipt of C. E. WEBSTER's letter, he contacted the U.S. Air Force Intelligence locally and they stated the matter should be left up to the FBI, however, they would appreciate being kept advised of developments.

No further investigation appears warranted at CV, however, CV will accept all information furnished by [redacted] and RAND and advise the Bureau in form suitable for dissemination.
