

On July 31, 1962, photographs of Ivan Alexandrovitch (5) 8-5-96 Shishkin and his wife, Zinaida Shishkin were (5) SLD KSR displayed to Robert Edward Webster, 31 East 8-1-96 Beaver St., Zelienople, Pa., who renounced his United States citizenship and resided at Leningrad, (JFK) Russia, from 1959 to May, 1962. Webster advised that the Shishking were unknown to him; that he had not met (5) them in Russia; and that he could furnish no information concerning them.

It is noted that in May, 1962, Webster advised Special Agents of the Federal Bureau of Investigation that he was in contact with one Alexander Shishkin at the American National Exhibition in Moscow in 1959. On July 31, 1962 Webster stated that he had been mistaken concerning the name of this individual and that he should have identified him as Michael Shishkin. According to Webster, Michael (5) Shishkin is not identical with Ivan Alexandrovitch shishkin MC
