Special Agent William J. Farrell, Jr. of your Laboratory has conducted certain inquiry in Guatemala concerning the matter as result of which he will be a necessary witness in the case.

A subpoena will be served on Mr. Farrell calling for his testimony in New Orleans on October 31, 1963. However, it will be necessary for Government counsel to go over Mr. Farrell's findings with him prior to the date set for his Court appearance, and it is therefore requested that he be in New Orleans on October 29, 1963 to confer with Edward Molenof in the matter.
