Remylet 10/31/63 and Bulet 11/6/63; reports of SA STEPHEN J. LABADIE, Tampa, 9/30/63 and 10/28/63; and Miami teletype 10/28/63; all in captioned matter. Bureau's observations in referenced letter well taken and Tampa has received no new information from sources indicating that the installation would be overly productive.

Daily spot checks and information received through TP 120-C fail to indicate residence is used as a meeting place.

In view of the Bureau's request as to portion of time subject spends, the following observations are noted from a review of the referenced matters:

From the above it would appear that subject from August 18 to October 31 was in Tampa only fourteen days, it being further noted that JAMES C. LONGO and his brother, SAM TRAFFICANTE, were the only individuals observed to enter the Tampa residence, and according to TP 120-C this source indicates subject had no visitors at his Tampa residence during this period.
