He stated that there was definitely an organization among the Italians and although they used him on occasions, he never was accepted as a member because of his drinking habits and the fact that he was continually getting into trouble. He stated the old group was under PHIL BUCCOLA and consisted of JOSEPH LOMBARDI; JOSEPH BRUNO (deceased); FRANK CUCCHIARA; MICHAEL ROCCO; HENRY SELVITELLA, also known as Henry Noyes; BIG BOZO CORTESE (deceased); ANTHONY SANTANIELLO (deceased); and an old individual named PEPINO who was connected with the American Finance Company located on Hanover Street, Boston, Massachusetts.

When BUCCOLA left Boston and took up residence in Italy, RAYMOND L. S. PATRIARCA became the boss of Rhode Island, Massachusetts, Maine and New Hampshire. He was also considered to be the boss of the Hartford area in the State of Connecticut.
