PH 672-C-TE INTERVIEWED AT LENGTH THIS DATE. CI IDENTIFIED ADDITIONAL MEMBERS OF PHILA FAMILY OF LA COSA NOSTRA AND ELABORATED ON PREVIOUS INFORMATION FURNISHED RE RANK IN PHILA FAMILY. HE AGREED TO GO TO NEW JERSEY ON MONDAY TO POINT OUT GRAVESITE FOR VANISHED LA COSA NOSTRA VICTIMS.
