ascertained that FRANK NICOLETTI and IGNAZIO DENARO will meet source at 8:30 p.m. in front of 911 South Eighth Street to furnish informant transportation to La Cosa Nostra meeting. Possibly six individuals, identity unknown to informant, will be "made" at instant meeting. Informant learned from BRUNO that he will also be given the "new rules" of La Cosa Nostra.

On 5/25/64, informant agreed to wear recording device while attending this meeting in effort to record induction ceremony of La Cosa Nostra.

Philadelphia in 5/18/64 teletype advised that they would make recommendations concerning La Cosa Nostra initiation and information re alleged burial grounds of La Cosa Nostra in Cumberland County, N. J. Accordingly, Philadelphia recommends that no open investigation be undertaken at this time re burial grounds in Cumberland County, N. J. This recommendation is made not to jeopardize informant, noting that individuals allegedly buried vanished from Philadelphia area more than 20 years ago.

Philadelphia recommendations insofar as coverage of La Cosa Nostra meeting 6/15/64 as follows:

No open surveillance will be conducted UACB. Philadelphia contemplates extremely discreet coverage of bridges from Philadelphia area into New Jersey during pertinent period of evening of 6/15/64. Informant has suggested that meeting possibly will be at motel of PAT MASSI in Camden County, N. J.; however, this information is not known to be a fact.

It is requested that the Bureau grant authority so that the informant can record meeting. Philadelphia will, of course, secrete the recorder on the informant's body to afford all possible security. The informant is cognizant of the danger involved in having a recorder on his person while at this meeting. It is requested that the Laboratory at earliest date forward to Philadelphia the latest model Edwards By Maural Recorder with supplies and explanation as to operation.

The Bureau will be kept advised of developments in this matter.
