In connection with the subject's (S) scheduled departure (S) on home leave, attention is called to the fact that the building superintendent at (S) subject's residence (S) was not sure just when (S) MISHUKOV and his family (S) would be moving (S) out of (S) Apartment 9-C, 40 W. 84th Street. Both (S) MISHUKOV (S) and (S) Soviet IVAN A. BELOV, who shares (S) Apartment 9-C, notified the building superintendent that they were moving. One of them stated that he would be moving out by mid May, while the other advised that he would leave by June 1, 1960; however, the building superintendent did not recall which was which. (S)
