On 8/2/63, it was ascertained that CHERRY had made his bond of \$2,000 set on narcotics charges through a bondsman from Fort Worth, Texas by the name of L. S. JOHNSON. Prior to being turned over to Federal authorities to make his bond on three separate charges, Sheriff BILL DECKER, Dallas County SO, advised that they are filing criminal charges against CHERRY for burglary.

ALA:

CHERRY presently has two indictments from Kansas City, Missouri for ITSP violations. Total bond recommended on these two charges is \$7,500. CHERRY also has ITSP charges outstanding at Baton Rouge, Louisiana and bond recommended on these charges, \$10,000.

On 8/1/63, PCI [] advised that from information he has heard JOHN ELI STONE and MILLER, who were arrested by the IRS Agents during the latter part of June, 1963, have returned to bookmaking on a very limited basis. [] related by this he means they are having personal contact with their customers rather than using the telephone. He advised that it is his understanding that STONE has several customers in the Meadows Building located on the North Central Expressway.

On 8/2/63, at approximately 1:30 PM, STONE was observed conversing with MILLER in the Enquire Shine and Press Shop located in downtown Dallas. Previous investigation indicated that MILLER is part owner of the Shine and Press Shop.
