On 9/6/63, Lt. JACK REVILL, Intelligence Squad, Dallas PD, advised that subject DAVIS had been arrested by officers of the Dallas PD Vice Squad on the night of 9/5/63, shortly after he was observed leaving the Redmen Club, 1606 1/2 Young Street. (Previous investigation ascertained this private club was being used by its members and proprietor for gambling activities, specifically high stake poker games, and also that the manager of the club is notorious Dallas hoodlum RUSSELL DOUGLAS MATTHEWS, DL 166-102). DAVIS had \$2,800 in cash on his person and some "crooked" gambling paraphernalia which consisted of very small thin mirrors about the size of a contact lense which he would place on the inner side of his index finger on his left hand and as he dealt cards he could see if the card dealt was a face card and the color of same.

Texas On 9/3/63, DL 170-C (DL 137-566) advised that WINFREY had just recently moved from the apartment house on Simpson and had now set up his operation at Dallas telephone LAKESIDE 6-2772. Informant stated WINFREY is in bad financial straights at the present time and was informants opinion that WINFREY would again work for JOHN ELI STONE (DL 162-37) when the football season commenced in the near future. An immediate check with confidential source in the telephone company, Dallas, ascertained that the above telephone number was connected 8/6/63, and was listed to HARRY WATSON (alias of WINFREY) at apartment 11, 4014 Travis Street, Dallas. A BuAgent checked the parking lot of this apartment house on 9/3/63 and observed WINFREY's Oldsmobile parked there. The above information was furnished to Lt. JACK REVILL on 9/5/63.

On 9/3 and 5/63, LITTLE's residence in Irving, Texas, and the apartment house where he had been operating in Grand Prairie, Texas, were checked, however, no automobiles known to be used by LITTLE or associate MELVIN COX, were observed. Chief of Police FRED CONOVER, Grand Prairie, Texas, advised officers had not observed LITTLE's car at the apartment house in over a month.
