On 11/13/63 CI furnished the following information:

Re Gambling Activities, Dallas, (DL 162-1), CI advised that he was never recontacted by either EARL LUMPKIN, "BUCK" BAKER, or MARCUS PEYTON (Phonetic) concerning \$5,000 bet on Baylor-Texas game. CI was unable to identify unknown Fort Worth individual for whom these men were attempting to place bet.

CI advised that the Club Montmartre has been extremely quiet lately, that the manager JIMMY VOURAS has

the FBI any pertinent information and that MATTHEWS should leave OWENS alone. CI further advised that DAVIS' employee, GARLAND POLLARD, has available the latest changes in the "line" shortly after 10:00 a.m. each Friday and Saturday morning. CI also advised that DAVIS and POLLARD continue to have available the "big line" which contains a point spread on practically every game scheduled between major colleges while the other line available in Dallas is limited to about half the number of games being played.

CI advised that MATTHEWS (DL 166-102) and JOSEPH "SOFIE" GEBRON are presently operating as bookmakers in the Dallas area, but CI has been unable to obtain their phone number unless it is the number where MATTHEWS is presently residing in Irving, Texas, with prostitute DONNA SUE HELTON.

Re NORVELL YOUNG STANFIELD, aka. (DL 165-153), CI advised that STANFIELD and his boss, GEORGE FREDERICK RECHENBERG continue to have their bookmaking operation located in the Dorchester House Apartments. (This was verified through daily observation by Bureau Agents of STANFIELD's car parked at this apartment house during the past week.) CI also advised that on 11/11/63 RECHENBERG closely questioned CI concerning possible "leaks" of information concerning RECHENBERG's operations. RECHENBERG was seeking CI's assistance to ascertain who was talking to the FBI about RECHENBERG, and RECHENBERG did suspect CI. RECHENBERG is convinced someone is talking as the FBI seems to know whenever RECHENBERG moves or sets up a new place of operation. RECHENBERG seemed to be extremely worried.
