On October 14, 1964 Cecil/CHERNICK, 32 Wasdale Crescent, Toronto, was interviewed at his place of employment, Abe's Meat Market, 3195 Bathurst Street, Toronto. CHERNICK is our FPS No. 561937, born March 10, 1922. He advised that he met GROSSI in prison and has seen him on about two occasions since his release in 1957. He admits receiving a cheque from GROSSI's wife and stated that he forwarded it to GROSSI at General Delivery, Daytona Beach, Florida. CHERNICK claims GROSSI was in Toronto approximately two months ago, which would be the latter part of July or early August 1964. At that time, according to CHERNICK, GROSSI was driving a 1963 maroon Grand Prix Pontiac bearing unknown Texas licence plates. When leaving he told CHERNICK he was going to visit his wife in Ottawa, Ontario. CHERNICK said he has not seen GROSSI since that time and when asked if he would advise us if he learned of GROSSI's whereabouts, CHERNICK declined, stating he would not inform on anyone but assured us that he did not know his present location.

- 2. A check of the usual sources in Toronto and area were negative. The Ontario Provincial Police have circularized the description of the Cadillac and the Pontiac Grand Prix automobile.
- To assist us in conducting additional inquiries, it is requested that you supply one additional copy of your original request which was received here with your referral slip dated September 11, 1904.
