Please refer to your 13330 dated 4th January 1961, with which you forwarded a copy of an I.N.S. list of persons who

had been served with a "Notice of prevention of departure". Our office in Jamaica have informed us that an application

has been received by the Jamaican Government for a visa for Edward J. WHITEHOUSE, born 14th March 1914, to come to Jamaica as supervisor of an airline which operates between Jamaica and Venezuela. Subject is apparently a Cuban and his visa application was accordingly referred to our office in Kingston.

In view of the fact that subject appeared on the Immigration and Naturalisation Service's black list, Jamaica is not keen on having him there if it is still the view of the United States authorities that he justifies retention on the black list.

- We shall be grateful if this can be checked and if we can be told what information available may be passed to the Jamaican security authorities.
- It would seem that refusal by Jamaica of a Cuban visa application would not endanger sources but should Jamaica decide to do this in respect of a person on the I.N.S. black list presumably covering approval from I.N.S. should first be obtained. We shall be grateful for your comments.
