On 2/21/68, NO 1457-C-TE advised that on 2/15/68, CARLOS MARCELLO went to Baton Rouge, La., for a secret meeting relative to the labor racketeering situation in Baton Rouge. Informant does not know the identity of individuals with whom MARCELLO met, however, informant stated that when MARCELLO's chauffeur, JOHNNY LA BRUZZO, arrived in Baton Rouge, MARCELLO became highly incensed because the meeting was arranged at "the motel where the press hangs out." MARCELLO did not go in but he had JOHNNY LA BRUZZO arrange for the meeting to take place in a nearby motel.

NO 1457-C-TE further advised that on 2/17/68, MARCELLO attended another meeting in Baton Rouge that was a lengthy meeting. This also was a secret meeting relative to the labor situation.

Informant further advised that on 2/20/68, MARCELLO again went to Baton Rouge, La., for a secret conference with unknown individuals relative to the labor situation.

On 2/20/68, a staff official of the La. State Labor Racketeering Commission, advised that the Commission had been informed that CARLOS MARCELLO was in Baton Rouge on 2/15/68, and was to meet with EDWARD GRADY PARTIN, teamster
