11. Possibilities of obtaining desired information by other means

(Explain in detail):

Some of subject's movements can be obtained by surveillance and informants; however, detailed information re day-to-day activities and movements of subject, particularly information regarding subject's membership and activities in the "Commission" cannot be obtained through any other sources.

12. Risks of detection involved:

Through contacts, telephone service at address will be interrupted. Sound Agent under pretext will make necessary installation during repair to restore telephone service. Technically, it has been ascertained that there is in existence necessary wiring in the building for installation of a 42A which will not be detected and will take only a few minutes for installation. This plan will be executed when subject is not present. If during the execution of this plan a question of security or risk arises, the installation will not be made. The building is three stories with apartments on the second and third floors. The above-described plan at present appears to be the only method for completing installation.

13. Probable length of technical surveillance:

Surveillance will be continued as long as productive.
