By airtel, 4/4/61, Miami advised that on 4/4/61, an attempted interview with JOE SMITH, owner of the Cold Coast Restaurant and associate of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., was unsuccessful because of SMITH's completely uncooperative attitude.

On 4/4/61, SA MI-C advised SA ROBERT T. WILSON as follows:

On that date, MARTIN LUTHER KING and MISS PATRICIA (former Pittsburgh Top Bookies), accompanied by a young blonde, unidentified W/M, visited the offices of Associated Theaters, Inc., 76 Van Buren St., Pittsburgh. They were there to discuss leasing arrangements for the newly located theater, Leaning Road, Lower Merion Township, Westmoreland County, Pa. This theater was originally owned by BILLY and SAM WILSON and was sold to MISS PATRICIA who loaned it to Associated Theaters, Inc. It was indicated that MARTIN LUTHER KING and the unknown W/M were occupying a suite at the Pittsburgher Hotel, Pittsburgh, and SMITH's Miami, Florida, telephone was set out as (305) 6-4073.

On 4/6/61, JIM SMITH, Manager, Pittsburgher Hotel, advised that MISS PATRICIA checked out of the hotel on that date and
