THE CAIMINAL "COMMISSION" ST AL AR - CONSPIRACY

In further developing our plan of action against La Causa Mostra, the name used by its members in identifying the Italian criminal organization, the Bureau is considering the recommendation of new legislation to cope more effectively with this organization, its leaders and its members. The fact that such a recommendation is under consideration is not to be discussed with anyone outside the Bureau at this time.

In reviewing data developed to date in this investigation, of particular importance for the above purposes is information received from member-sources concerning the initiation
ceremony, oath, and rules governing members. For legislative
purposes, in laying groundwork for the conclusive establishment
of Causa Mostra as a de facto organization, the fact that each
of these member-sources has furnished substantially identical
accounts of initiation, oath, and rules will be of great
significance. This will be particularly true considering that
descriptions of the initiation coremony furnished by members
received into this organization in the 1950s are identical to an
account furnished by a source who was initiated as a member in
1930. Of similar significance is the fact that these accounts
were received from sources, unknown to one another, as far
separated as New York and San Francisco.

It can be appreciated that the aspects of initiation, oath, rules, and permanence of the organization which will be of greatest weight will be those which, of themselves, suggest contravention of certain provisions of the U. 3. Constitution and of the common good. For example, one veteran member has divulged that the cath consisted, in part, of swearing to place his country, family and religion in a secondary position to his allegiance to Causa Kostra. Another source has expressed this similarly by recounting that part of his eath of membership consisted of swearing to place the organization in a position of supremecy over all class in his life.

and in reports under this caption, it is not of great importance that we delineate in most specific terms the nature and purposes of this organization, setting forth complete detail of membership, including initiation coremony, oath, preparation leading up to membership, background investigation conducted on proposed members, et detera, to provide a firm basis for any forthcoming recommended legislation.

With this specific purpose in mind. Now York is to recontact member-sources developed to date and fully discuss the above in order to gather the greatest detail possible in these particular areas. To carry out this assignment New York should recentact Joseph Valachi, NY 3461-C-YE. NY 3341-C-YE and NY 3664-FC, and any other sources of which the Bureau may not be specifically aware who may be in a position to furnish firethand information concerning the above matters. It should be noted that boarsay-type information, though accurate, is not desired in this instance. Now York may wish to discuss this untter with MY 3505-C-TE, who, though he is not known to claim membership. may possibly be a rember. This observation is based on the letter source's extremely close association with leaders and members who appearently extend this source their full confidence. However, if exploring his position as a possible member vould tend to strain your relations with this informat, such a discussion need not be entered.

New York abould handle this discussion with NY 3864-PC lamodiately instauch as this source's availability for any extended paried is in question. You should also completely develop all other matters of interest pertaining to this organization and its leaders with this source for similar reasons.

Philadelphia should discuss this eatter with PE 509-PC and any other live source who may be in a position to furnish the firsthand data desired.

San Francisco should discuss the above aspects of this organization with SF 2550-C-TE. San Francisco may vish to discuss this matter with SF 2550-C, who, though he is not known to have acknowledged nembership, has been reported by SF 2550-C-TE to be a member.
