This is to advise the above informant has tentative plans to fly to visit his father in Buenos Aires, Argentina, leaving the United States on December 29, 1964, accompanied by two brothers and a sister.

CV-344-C states he will spend approximately two weeks in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and if there is any inquiry that he can make while there in behalf of the Bureau, he will be happy to make an attempt to obtain this information.

CV-344-C stated his father is in serious ill health and the trip is being made so he and his brothers and sister will arrive there in time for his birthday which is January 1.

The above information is also being brought to the attention of the Bureau, should the Bureau wish to bring this information to the attention of the Bureau representatives in Rio de Janeiro.

From previous correspondence to the Bureau, the Bureau is aware the informant's father is residing with relatives at 1372 Centenario, Capital 24, Buenos Aires, Argentina, and his family has made efforts to secure his re-entry into the United States on a parole status without success.

On his return to the United States, any information which has come to the attention of CV-344-C will be relayed to the Bureau.
