You have been previously informed of all information developed to date concerning the bombing of the Cuban-operated aircraft on 10/6/76 in the West Indies with the loss of 73 lives, as well as the information that the name of Legat Joseph S. Leo, Caracas, Venezuela was found on the person of one of the arrested suspects in that bombing.

Legat, Caracas reports in attached that with regard to the two Venezuelan citizens, Hernan Ricardo Lozano and Freddy Lugo, arrested on 10/7/76 by Trinidad police as suspects in aircraft bombing, he has been acquainted with Lozano since summer 1975, when Lozano requested visa assistance for family of superior. Lozano recontacted Legat on about three other occasions for visa information, last contacting Legat on 9/30/76 requesting visa assistance for himself. At that time Lozano claimed to be on an assignment in Jamaica and wanted a two-day stopover in Puerto Rico. Visa was issued on 10/1/76. Lozano was never a paid informant or source of Caracas Office. Freddy Lugo, the other arrested suspect is not known to Legat nor has here ever been a paid informant or source of the Caracas Office Lugo reportedly possessed Legat's name and telephone number on his person at time of arrest but Legat does not know how his name came into Lugo's possession. advised that the paper bearing his name appeared to have been taken from a notebook found in possession of Lozano, which contained more than 170 other names.

Legat further advised that neither Luis Posada Carriles, former Venezuelan Intelligence Service official and current employer of Lozano, and Ricardo Morales Navarrete, currently employed by Venezuelan Intelligence Service were never paid informants or sources of Caracas Office. It is noted, however, Navarrete is a former paid informant of the Miami Office.


