PH 614-C-TE LEARNED ANGELO BRUNO AND PHILIP TESTA, HIS NUMBER ONE LIEUTENANT, EVENING APRIL 6, 1962, MORNING APRIL 7, 1962, ATTENDED "ZIGNETTA CARD GAME" RUN BY FRANK MONTE, CHICKIE NARDUCCI, AND SONNY RICCOBENE. IDENTITY OF ACCOUNTANT WHO SET UP BOOKKEEPING SYSTEM PENN JERSEY VENDING APRIL 6, 1962 OBTAINED. PENN JERSEY VENDING, INC., UNDERGOING RENOVATION BEGINNING APRIL 10, 1962. FROM DESCRIPTION FURNISHED BY PH 614-C-TE, IT APPEARS PH 623-C* WILL NOT BE AFFECTED.

ON APRIL 9, 1962, PH 623-C* VERIFIED SUBJECT ATTENDING "ZIGNETTA GAME" AND STATED BRUNO PLAYED UNTIL FIVE O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING. ALSO VERIFIED THOSE IN ATTENDANCE.

BRUNO CONSIDERED DANGEROUS.
