Reference is made to the report of Special Agent Thomas G. Forsyth, III, Pittsburgh, dated September 30, 1963.

There follows a brief characterization of informants used in referenced report.

PG T-24 is an individual who has operated gambling establishments, horse rooms, and numbers stations in the Allegheny River Valley Section of Western Pennsylvania for almost 20 years.

PG T-32 is a businessman in Mercer County, Pa., who has a life-time association with gamblers and racketeers.

PG T-39 is a gambler and club operator in Pittsburgh, Pa.

PG T-52 is a law enforcement officer whose duties take him to most parts of Western Pennsylvania.

PG T-53 is an individual who has had many years experience in the numbers racket and other forms of gambling in the Monongahela Valley Section of Western Pennsylvania.
