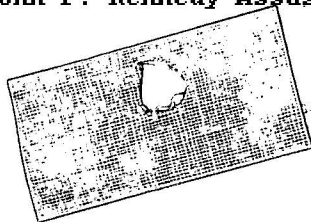

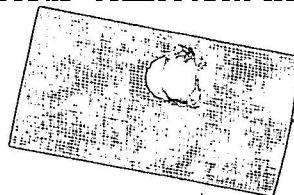

The Los Angeles office currently rents an apartment at 8410 Fountain Avenue, Los Angeles, for use as an observation post in connection with physical surveillances conducted of JUDITH E. CAMPBELL, 8401 Fountain Avenue, and in efforts to establish a highly confidential informant who can furnish information concerning CAMPBELL's activities.

CAMPBELL is a friend of JOHN ROSSELLI and also of SAM GIANCANA, Chicago hoodlum, to whom CAMPBELL makes numerous long distance telephone calls. On several occasions CAMPBELL has made long distance telephone calls to EVELYN LINCOLN, Confidential Secretary, White House, Washington, D.C.

At approximately 9:30 p.m. on 8/7/62 SA WILLIAM R. CARTER, who at the apartment at 8410 Fountain Avenue, observed two white males on the balcony of CAMPBELL's apartment at 8401 Fountain Avenue. The two men walked back and forth past the windows of CAMPBELL's apartment and peered inside. The drapes were drawn and lights were on in the living room of CAMPBELL's apartment.

One of the men appeared to knock on the window, and when he apparently received no answer, he opened the lanai type window and entered while the other man kept a lookout from a kneeling position on the balcony.

Descriptions of the two men were obtained by SA CARTER.

After one of the men entered the apartment, SA CARTER left the apartment at 8410 Fountain Avenue to endeavor to obtain a license number of an automobile the two men might have. He observed one of the two men enter a late model blue Chevrolet Corvette and drive hurriedly away. This car had no license plate on front. The rear license plate was a Texas plate, #EC2400. It hung down on one side as if it was not permanently affixed to the vehicle. The San Antonio office has been requested to furnish registration data re this Texas license plate.

SA CARTER did not observe if these men carried anything from CAMPBELL's apartment.

The above is furnished for the Bureau's information. UACB, this office will not disseminate this information to the LACSO, which has jurisdiction over this area for the following reasons: 1. It is not known if CAMPBELL will discover this burglary and this it would not be reported, or if she does discover it, whether she will report it. 2. The operation of the Los Angeles office in this matter, which made possible the observation of the burglary, is of an extremely sensitive nature. This office has made very few open inquiries concerning CAMPBELL's activities so that a highly confidential source, if developed, might prove more productive. It is my opinion that dissemination would most likely jeopardize the entire operation.

The Bureau will be kept advised of any pertinent information developed concerning this burglary.
