Descriptions of the two men were obtained by SA CARTER.

After one of the men entered the apartment, SA CARTER left the apartmenttat 8410 Fountain Avenue to endeavor to obtain a license number of an automobile the two men might have. He observed one of the two men enter a late model blue Chevrolet Corvette and drive hurriedly away. This car had no license plate on front. The rear license plate was a Texas plate, #EC2400. It hung down on one side as if it was not permanently affixed to the vehicle. The San Antonio office has been requested to furnish registration data re this Texas license plate.

SA CARTER did not observe if these men carried anything from CAMPBELL's apartment.

The above is furnished for the Bureau's information. UACB, this office will not disseminate this information to the LACSO, which has jurisdiction over this area for the following reasons: 1. It is not known if CAMPBELL will discover this burglary and this it would not be reported, or if she does discover it, whether she will report it. 2. The operation of the Los Angeles office in this matter, which made possible thesobservation of the burglary, is of an extremely sensitive nature. This office has made very few open inquiries concerning CAMPBELL's activities so that a highly confidential source, if developed, might prove more productive. It is my opinion that dissemination would most likely jeopardize the entire operation.

The Bureau will be kept advised of any pertinent information developed concerning this burglary.
