Enclosed are 12 copies of a letterhead memorandum
(LHM) dated and captioned as above.

Copies of this LHM are being disseminated locally
to INS, ONI, OSI, CIA, State Dept., Cuban Affairs Office,
U. S. Border Patrol, U. S. Coast Guard, U. S. Customs,
Region II, U. S. Customs, Miami, and G-2, Ft. Mc Pherson, Ga.

On 5/15/64, Mrs. PHYLLIS WOLF, secretary to the
District Director, INS, Miami, advised she personally handles
much of the liaison with CIA, Miami. Miss WOLF confidentially
advised that CIA was nervous and apprehensive of the MRR
press releases on 5/13/64. CIA felt no press releases should
have been issued by the MRR in the United States.

On 5/15/64, WALLACE SHANLEY, Assistant U. S. Customs
Agent in Charge, Miami, advised that the U. S. State Dept.
Co-Ordinator of Cuban Affairs HARVEY SUMM feared MRR press
releases might somehow involve the U. S. Government.
