ADMINISTRATIVE:

On 7/27/71, PG878-C-TE advised:

Yesterday ~~SONNY CIANCUTTI~~ telephonically contacted informant and said that KELLY MANNARINO wanted to see him. Informant met with MANNARINO at the latter's ranch in Allegheny Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, on the morning of 7/27/71.

MANNARINO said he has a friend "out west" who is in trouble, and "I may have to help him." MANNARINO wouldn't tell informant anything more but merely insisted informant keep himself instantly available to leave to "do a job" for this unidentified friend of his. MANNARINO said informant could take along a partner of his own choosing or he could take SONNY CIANCUTTI. MANNARINO turned to CIANCUTTI and said, "You go with him and get dirty; it's about time." Informant has no additional information at this time.

MANNARINO then asked informant if he knew GALLO in New York, and informant said he only knows what he reads about GALLO in magazines. MANNARINO asked if informant knew what GALLO looks like, and informant said he has only seen magazine photographs of GALLO. MANNARINO then said, "He may come up next;" and MANNARINO said no more.

From his conversation with MANNARINO, during which he did not ask any questions since so doing would be uncharacteristic, he can only surmise that MANNARINO may have been talking about a "hit" for his friend "out west" or a "muscle job" or a "burglary," but there is no way of being sure without more information. Informant will try to get additional information from CIANCUTTI if possible.

PHIL (LNU) and FREDDIE (LNU), both from Indiana County and the latter an official with the local of the Iron workers Union. Then he heard that BAZZANO was going into some sort of a deal with PHIL to operate a hotel in that area. Somebody went to KELLY MANNARINO and falsely informed him that informant had a silent piece of PHIL's share of the new venture and that informant hoped BAZZANO was not going into the deal with the idea of fleecing PHIL. Shortly thereafter, MANNARINO brought in BAZZANO, sat him down and told him that he should either operate the hotel deal on the square or not go into it at all. Reportedly, BAZZANO assured MANNARINO that his intentions were strictly legitimate.

E. LEGITIMATE ENTERPRISE

On January 25, 1971, PG T-3 advised:

GABRIEL "KELLY" MANNARINO reputedly owns 51% of a firm known as Paragon Plastics in the New Kensington - Allegheny River Valley area and the other owner is allegedly NEIL HAGEAL. Some of associates of MANNARINO and individuals that work in his organization are "SPEEDO" HANNA, who is a torpedo, and also an individual known as "BAD EYE", who is married to HAGEAL's sister.

This information is just rumor among gamblers in the New Kensington area, and it is known that when he is in town, MANNARINO spends no time at Paragon Plastics and continues to actively operate Catoris Candies, Inc.

F. TRAVEL

On January 15, 1971, RAYMOND ECHEMENT, Deputy U.S. Marshal, Pittsburgh, telephonically advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH, III, that GABRIEL MANNARINO had just boarded United Airlines Flight Number 905, which departed Pittsburgh at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, en route to Ft. Lauderdale, Fla. He said MANNARINO, traveling under his own name, had a male traveling companion, no description obtained, who was traveling under the name S. MANNARINO.

It is noted that SAMUEL MANNARINO, subject's brother, has been dead for about four years, and no other MANNARINO is known to have a first name commencing with the letter "S."
