Re Los Angeles airtel to Bureau 7/21/67, and report of SA JOSEPH D. DOMZALSKI, 5/10/67, at New York City, entitled "HOM Jin-get, aka, IS-CH." Los Angeles letter to Bureau 10/25/66, entitled "CHEN Hsiang, aka, IS-CH." (S)

As the New York Office is aware, Los Angeles source DINA visited New York during a recent trip to Canada. The following details of his contacts at New York were furnished to SA NORMAN R. JOHNSON on 7/19/67, and 7/31/67. This information is not being placed in a form suitable for dissemination at Los Angeles inasmuch as the source is included in the group of individuals attending a function at the "China Daily News" (CDN) and it would tend to identify him.

DINA arrived in New York on Saturday, 7/8/67, and stayed at the home of a friend, LEE Moon-wa (LI Wen-ho (M) 2621/2429/0735). LEE operates a laundry and resides at 9016 Elmhurst Street. The source remained with LEE and his family Saturday evening and Sunday morning.

At about 3:00 PM, Sunday 7/9/67, DINA went to the offices of the CDN. A stockholders meeting was taking place; however, this was very informal and people just walked in and out of the room where this stockholders meeting was taking place. There was no way of identifying individuals.

as being stockholders. After this there was some balloting for members of the Chung Wa Kung Sze (Chinese company). The source did not know the final result of this balloting. There was no discussion concerning the financial condition of the paper nor was there any formal meeting of any type. There was a party during which refreshments were served and a movie depicting a Peking opera was shown. There was no particular political significance to this movie. (u)

[DINA] (S) identified the following six caucasians as being in attendance at the CDN function: (S)

(1) Mr. [EDID] (S) (u)  
 This individual is about 70 to 75 years of age and a former insurance agent. His wife was sick and was hospitalized as of the date of this function. EDID is a good friend of YEE Sun-jok, a former official of the CDN now residing in Macao. EDID corresponds frequently with YEE and YEE has sent small gifts such as pillows to EDID. EDID became friendly with the source and his wife and expressed an interest in sending some type of Communist literature to the source at some future date.

(2) (3) Mr. and Mrs. [LOUIE] (S) (u)  
 This was a Negro couple. They were accompanied by their daughter who was about 12 or 13 years of age. They arrived late while the movie was being shown and left shortly thereafter. The source had no opportunity for conversation with these persons, but they appeared very friendly with the other people in attendance.

(4) (5) SUE FRANK and Husband (S) (u)  
 The source conversed with SUE FRANK and her husband who mentioned that they had visited the Chinese Mainland in 1960 or 1961. While there they visited an old friend from the CDN named TONG Ming-chiu (TANG Ming-chao (M) 0781/2494/3564). TONG was described by the FRANKS as being the number two man in the Department of Overseas Chinese.

(6) KIRA GOLLOBIN. (S)(u)

The source became friendly with this individual who is about 44 years of age and has an office at 1441 Broadway New York City. He is a former attorney for YEE Sun-jok and indicated that he was interested in maintaining a friendship with the source. (S)(u)

Also in attendance at this function was a Mr. LEONG. This individual was a Chinese from Columbia, South America and was a friend of SETO Wong. The source was unable to ascertain any further background concerning LEONG. (S)(u)

The source noted that the following individuals were in attendance at this function. [DINA] furnished the Chinese character for the names of these individuals which have been transliterated. The first version is the Cantonese which is the most commonly used name in most instances: (S)

On Monday, 7/10/67, [DINA] (S) visited with [OH Kow] (S) at 298 Broome Street. This individual has taken over the laundry previously operated by [YEE Sun-jok] (S). He said that next year they hope to have movies of the Chinese atomic bomb explosions to be shown at the [CDN] party. He also expressed the opinion that the Chicoms would take over Hong Kong sometime in the near future and he expressed happiness over this thought. (S)

On 7/10/67, [DINA] (S) also visited [CHAN Sheung (7115/4161)] (S) at his residence. [CHAN] (S) lives in Apartment 39 (S) in the housing project which is located on the corner of [Bayard and Elizabeth] (S) Streets. [CHAN] (S) said he was unable to return to Hong Kong and Macao because of his financial condition. He indicated that during the latter part of last year he had made investments in the Dreyfus Fund. He has lost considerable amounts of money in this investment. [DINA] (S) stated that [CHAN] (S) is married and has no children. He is about 55 years of age and currently unemployed. He indicated that he has considered adopting a child. (S)

During the [CDN] meeting, [DINA] (S) determined that [CHAN Kam-tong] (S) is in charge of the wet wash. [DINA] (S) identified [HOM Kwok-sun] (S) as being identical with a photograph of an individual known as [HOM Get-jin] (S). This photograph had been displayed to [DINA] (S) on a previous occasion. (S)

On Tuesday, 7/11/67, [DINA] (S) spent most of the day with his family in New York prior to departing for Canada. (S)

The Bureau and New York will be advised in the event [DINA] (S) recalls any further information concerning activities in New York City. The source will also be available to assist in identifying further any of the above named individuals. (S)
