Bureau concurs with your observation with respect to subject's trips abroad. Since past experience has shown that subject's trips primarily include areas where the FBI has Legal Attache assignments, it is felt that any intensive coverage of subject's activities while abroad should be handled by established source of these Legats. (c)

As you are aware, a memorandum summarizing subject's background and prior activities was furnished Legat, London, prior to subject's last trip abroad. Legat, London, was instructed to furnish this memorandum to the head of the British Security Service for its use in affording extensive coverage to the subject during any subsequent visits to England by the subject. (c)

If current information is received indicating a planned trip abroad by subject to areas covered by other Legats, a copy of the above-mentioned memorandum will be furnished those Legats concerned together with a request that through sources attempts be made to determine her activities. (c)

Accordingly, New York should be alert for any information indicating subject or her husband intend to travel abroad; and this information should be furnished the Bureau by appropriate communication commensurate with the amount of time needed to alert appropriate Legats.

NOTE: Subject is active in pro-Chicom matters in the U. S. and is suspected of engaging in intelligence activities for the Chicoms. A series of recent information developed by New York indicates subject may be planning another trip abroad.

The subject continues her close association with JAMES and ANN LEE of the "China Daily News", and she and her husband attended the annual celebration at the "China Daily News" as they have done in past years.

On 5/4/67, NY 5225-S* was visited at his home by the subject and her husband. The subject said they were in the informant's neighborhood and decided to visit the informant. The visit was social in nature, and there was very little political discussion. (S)(u)

Since this time, NY 5225-S* has been assigned by the CPUSA to the Professional Section of the CPUSA. Because of this, it is felt that it is unlikely that there will be any further contact between the subject and NY 5225-S*. (S)(u)

Subject has, in the past, lectured to groups of Iranian students. In this regard, the NYO is exploring the possibility of putting NY 5678-S in contact with the subject. (S)(u)

On 8/2/67, the subject attempted to contact LEO HUBERMAN at the offices of "Monthly Review". As pointed out in relet, the subject only contacts HUBERMAN just prior to or subsequent to a trip abroad.

On 8/10/67, the subject attempted to contact IRA GOLLOBIN. She said at this time that she was trying to renew her passport and wanted some legal advice.

It appears from the above that the subject is contemplating another trip abroad.

The subject's recent activities conform to the pattern of her activities over the course of this investigation.

Recommendations of the NYO

The NYO is constantly alert to the possibility of developing the contacts of the subject as informants. However, the subject's contacts are very limited. They are almost exclusively individuals who are pro-Chinese Communist or at least individuals with a long history of leftist activity.
