The subject continues her close association with JAMES and ANN LEE of the "China Daily News", and she and her husband attended the annual celebration at the "China Daily News" as they have done in past years.

On 5/4/67, NY 5225-S* was visited at his home by the subject and her husband. The subject said they were in the informant's neighborhood and decided to visit the informant. The visit was social in nature, and there was very little political discussion.

Since this time, NY 5225-S* has been assigned by the CPUSA to the Professional Section of the CPUSA. Because of this, it is felt that it is unlikely that there will be any further contact between the subject and NY 5225-S*.

Subject has, in the past, lectured to groups of Iranian students. In this regard, the NYO is exploring the possibility of putting NY 5678-S in contact with the subject.

On 8/2/67, the subject attempted to contact LEO HUBERMAN at the offices of "Monthly Review". As pointed out in relet, the subject only contacts HUBERMAN just prior to or subsequent to a trip abroad.

On 8/10/67, the subject attempted to contact IRA GOLLOBIN. She said at this time that she was trying to renew her passport and wanted some legal advice.

It appears from the above that the subject is contemplating another trip abroad.

The subject's recent activities conform to the pattern of her activities over the course of this investigation.

Recommendations of the NYO

The NYO is constantly alert to the possibility of developing the contacts of the subject as informants. However, the subject's contacts are very limited. They are almost exclusively individuals who are pro-Chinese Communist or at least individuals with a long history of leftist activity.
