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Re phone call from ASAC W.D.GRIFFITH to SA FAYHOUD H. PORTER 11/19/57 and Albany airtel to Bureau #11/16/57.

The following investigation conducted at Rochester, N.Y.:

On 11/19/57 AL MDSS, reporter, Rochester Times-Union advised SA ROETRT G.
AULENBACHER he had interviewed STANLEY VALENTI on 11/15/57 for the purpose of determing
the reason for STANLEY and his brother FRANK VALENTI, both of Rochester attending the
captioned meeting.

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MOSS stated STANLEY claimed he and FRANK had heard JOSEPH BARBURA had been sick and they went to BARBURA's home to pay him a friendly visit. MOSS advised he did not ask STANLEY if others were present at BARBURA's home at the time, but STANLEY did admit they had been stopped by the NYSP, but did not say what the troopers asked ther.

On 11/19/57 JULIUS GINSPIRG, wa. "Whitey", operator of a "Cirar Store" and a gambler at 257 N. Clinton Ave., whose identity should be kept confidential in view of GINSBERG being considered as a possible ICI, advised SA FUGENT A. THURON be is ac tainted with STANLEY VALENTI, but only knows of FRANK VALUETI by "reputation as a booling out of Pittsburgh.

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stated he has often thought that the VALVITI boys would possibly attempt to "shake down" the gamblers in Rochester, but this has not occured to date. advised he had no idea why the VALENTI boys attended the meeting at OTHER 4 Bing's ton, I.Y. He further advised he knows several "Italians " in Rochester who are acquainted with the Vallill boys, but none of these people would divulge any information.

On 11/19/57 WILLIAM MASUCCI, wa. "Willie Hoppe", operator of a "Ciear Store" whose identity must be kept confidential and a gambler at 408 State St./advised Sa MVVRON he is acquainted with STANIBY VALENTI and knows of FRANK VALENTI by F reputation" as a hoodlum. MASUCCI advised STANLEY VALUATI is the "boss" of the treasury tickets in Rochester and is getting by because he is the brother of FRANK VALENTI who is alleged to be a "tough guy".

MASUCCI advised he handles the "colonial tickets" and up to about a year and a half ago received his ticket service wat out of Syracuse, N.T., MASUCCI said at that time his contact in Syracuse advised him, he was no longer handling the ticket service as the "mob" was taking over and MASUCCI would in the future get his tickets from a minner for STAPLFY VALLATI.

MASUCCI advised he was contacted by an agent for STAMLEY VALENTI and in view of the commission being the same decided to take the tickets from VAIFNTI, He said the only tickets bulny roll in Machinetar pe the "Pendagua", "Feoglets Club" and the "Bolonial", these tickets being printed either in Endicatt. W. V. or outside of Todicott, M. T. and corviced by AMPHONY F. (GUV) GUARNIERI, Endicott, N.Y. (one of the individuals who attended captioned meeting).

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
