Reurlet May 6, 1952, captioned "Junta Revolucionaria
Constitutional."

There is enclosed for the Legal Attache, Havana, one
copy of a letter from the Miami Office dated May 8, 1952,
captioned "Carlos Prio Socarros, Foreign Political Matter -
Cuba, Neutrality Act." There is enclosed for the Legal Attache,
Havana, and Miami Office one copy of an information report from
Central Intelligence Agency dated April 25, 1952, dealing with
a possible attempt to overthrow the present Cuban administration.

The Miami Office has additionally advised by teletype
of May 12, 1952, that the Immigration and Naturalization Service
manifest on Pan-American Airways, Flight 416, March 19, 1952,
reflects that Jose Luis Francisco Fernandez Espinosa, age 28, a
Cuban National, in possession of Visa V1737563, Libio Hermogenes
Peralta Recojo, age 42, a Cuban National, Visitor's Permit
T2490343 and Ricardo Florencio Suarez Rodriguez, age 25, a Cuban
National, in possession of Visitor's Permit T2550958, traveled
from Havana, Cuba, to Miami, Florida, as a party and were all
destined to the Leamington Hotel, Miami. From the manifest, it
appears that Suarez Rodriguez is probably identical with M-1
mentioned in your referenced letter. According to Miami, Scalco
Peter is probably identical with Peter Scalco, 414 Southwest
