U.S. COAST GUARD, MIAMI, THAT EIGHT INDIVIDUALS CONSISTING OF FIVE CUBAN

AND THREE AMERICANS WERE PICKED UP BY A BRITISH GUARD SHIP AT

ANGUILA KEY, BRITISH BAHAMAS, ON JUNE ONE, SIXTYFOUR. MIAMI CONTACTED

GREGG BENTLEY, NIGHT JUNE TWO, BAHAMIAN POLICE, NASSAU

WHO CONFIRMED THAT EIGHT INDIVIDUALS IDENTITIES UNKNOWN HAD BEEN

PICKED UP AT ANGUILA KEY ALONG WITH A QUANTITY OF ARMS AND EQUIPMENT

AND WERE BEING TRANSPORTED TO NASSAU BY A BRITISH GUARD SHIP WHICH ALSO

SEIZED THEIR TWENTYFIVE ^{FOOT} BOAT. THESE EIGHT INDIVIDUALS EXPECTED TO

ARRIVE NASSAU MORNING OF JUNE THREE.

BENTLEY THEN EXPECTS TO OBTAIN COMPLETE DETAILS, IDENTIFYING DATA, AND WILL FURNISH RESULTS TO THIS OFFICE.

ANDREW ST. GEORGE, THOMAS DUNCAN, AND MARTHA BARRAS.
