DE GASTER stated that prior to the departure of CHIBAS, CHIBAS made no further comment to him regarding the possibility of the JURE establishing some type of a base in Jamaica.

NY T-2 on June 29, 1964, advised that MANUEL RAY RIVERO, the national leader of JURE, arrived in New York City on June 27, 1964. NY T-2 stated that RAY spent most of June 28, 1964, in Connecticut where he spoke with one SAM HALPER Cann. who is believed to be connected with "Time" magazine.

NY T-2 advised that RAY was expected to be present at a meeting of JURE leaders on the night of June 29, 1964, at the home of a local leader, AVENOL FRANCO, 23-19 28th Street, Astoria, Long Island. N.Y.

NY T-2 also stated on June 29, 1964, that RAUL CHIBAS, the leader of JURE in New York City, is planning to leave New York for Miami, Florida, on July 1, 1964. NY T-2 said that CHIBAS was expected to spend at least two months in Miami, Florida, or until the new school term begins in the fall of 1964 when CHIBAS will return to assume his teaching duties in the New York area.

NY T-3, on June 30, 1964, advised that MANUEL "MANOLO" RAY arrived in New York on the night of June 27, 1964. NY T-3 stated that he had been informed

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is alleged to have said that he and his companions were within seven miles of Cuba when the engine failed. The article further stated that RAY related that the crippled boat fought the heavy seas and strong currents and "bravely" limped back to Florida.

N.Y. NY T-2, on July 20, 1964, advised that RAUL CHIBAS currently is residing in Miami, Florida, and is staying at the home of a relative, name unknown, who resides at 461 East Third Street, Hialeah, Florida, and his telephone number is 888-8833.

NY T-4, on July 30, 1964, advised that he has had no contact from RAUL CHIBAS or any member of the JURE in New York in over a month and does not anticipate being contacted by them in the immediate future as he understands that the JURE is badly torn by dissension.

NY T-3, on July 30, 1964, advised that he had recently been in contact with TAD SZULC, Washington correspondent for the "New York Times," D.C. who has been very much in favor of RAY and who has written several laudatory articles concerning RAY for the "New York Times." NY T-3 said that during this contact with SZULC, SZULC told him that MANUEL RAY was completely discredited, in his opinion, as a leader of Cuban exiles because of his two failures to get into Cuba.

NY T-3 stated that TAD SZULC told him that he had no further interest in expounding the cause of RAY and unless something spectacular occurred, would not write any more articles concerning RAY.
