There are enclosed the original and seven copies of a memorandum for the Bureau and two copies for Legat Paris containing information concerning subjects made available under a confidential classification by Chief Inspector ALEX BLACK, Special Branch, New Scotland Yard Officer assigned London Airport. Mr. BLACK is a confidential source of this office and he is being designated as T-1 in the enclosure to protect his identity. (b)

British Security Service MI-5 have also been alerted regarding subjects' presence in the United Kingdom and they will advise if any information of a security nature has been developed concerning them. Subjects arrived from Paris 9/30/59 and departed for Paris 10/4/59. (b)

These cases will be kept in a pending status and followed with MI-5. (b)

MARGARETE ADLER PITTMAN

T-1, a confidential source abroad, advised on October 1, 1959, that JOHN PITTMAN, his wife and two children arrived in the United Kingdom at London Airport from Paris, France, at 11:00 P.M., September 30, 1959. (S)

T-1 advised that upon arrival the subjects stated they would remain in the United Kingdom until Sunday, October 4, 1959, and would reside at the Mitre House, 180 Sussex Gardens, London, W. 2. T-1 further advised that the passports of the subjects contained no Soviet visas. (S)

On October 5, 1959, T-1 again advised that the subjects departed London via Air France for Paris at 10:00 P.M. on October 4, 1959. No information was obtained regarding their future travel plans and T-1 again stated that their passports did not contain Soviet visas. (S)
