On February 14, 1966, PG T-6 advised:

Recently, KELLY MANNARINO called an individual on the telephone and told this individual that he would give him "the book" for all types of bets, but this person stated, "What if I don't accept?" MANNARINO replied, "Think it over for one day and then I believe you will." It was rumored that this person thought it over and thereafter took the booking action. The unknown individual called at the time is still not known.

#### LA COSA NOSTRA

It is noted that it has been reported previously that sources have identified GABRIEL MANNARINO as a member of La Cosa Nostra.

On March 10, 1966, PG T-7 advised:

In a recent conversation with ANTHONY "WHITEY" BESASE, LCN member from Toledo, Ohio, BESASE stated that TONY DELSANTER, Warren, Ohio, is a member of the "Cleveland family." BESASE also indicated that he has been in frequent contact, of late, with KELLY MANNARINO and TONY RIPEPI, Pittsburgh members of La Cosa Nostra; however, informant was unable to ascertain the purpose of these contacts.

#### MISCELLANEOUS

On February 18, 1966, PG T-1 advised:

Recently, SAM MANNARINO stated that while he was incarcerated at United States Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pa., from mid-1964 to mid-1965, a building contractor named (FNU) DALEY had cheated him out of a substantial amount of money. According to MANNARINO, his brother, KELLY MANNARINO, and "some friends" had come to him, upon his release, and suggested the killing of DALEY, but MANNARINO claimed he dissuaded them from this course of action, saying that the risk involved was too great for the small amount of money he had lost.

With respect to the two specified items for the ADP programming, the following has been determined:

### Legitimate Enterprise

On 2/4/66, PG 775-C advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH, III as follows:

GABRIEL MANNARINO is half owner of Catoris Candies, Inc., a candy manufacturing and retail sales concern, located at 981 - 5th Avenue, New Kensington, Pa. While MANNARINO spends part of almost every day in his office at this company, he actually has little to do with its management, leaving that to the original owner, LOUIS CATORIS.

In addition, MANNARINO is still a partner with his brother, SAMUEL MANNARINO in the Nu Ken Novelty Company (a pinball and coin-operated amusement machines distributorship) and the S&S Distributing Company (a cigarette vending machine distributorship), both located at 1369 - 4th Avenue, New Kensington, Pa. However, GABRIEL MANNARINO has never been known to take an active part in the management of these companies.
