PG 545-C, who is personally acquainted with GABRIEL MANNARINO and his brother SAM, knows a great deal about their legitimate investments and has some knowledge of the scope of their gambling empire, and through these two channels, obtains information regarding their activities, associates and travel.

~~Former PG 511-C is as close to GABRIEL MANNARINO as a member of the family and can make available current information regarding his movements and interests.~~

Former PG 509-C, an admitted gambler who is well acquainted with the gambling element in Pittsburgh, Pa., and throughout the United States, and who is now in Florida, upon his return to Pittsburgh will be in a position to furnish information regarding MANNARINO, his activities and associates.

PG 564-C is acquainted with individuals connected with prostitution and gambling, and through these sources comes into possession of information concerning the MANNARINOS' activities and associates.

WALTER J. SHARKY, retired New Kensington, Pa., Police Department police sergeant, has furnished some information regarding GABRIEL MANNARINO and he is being developed in order to qualify him as a PCI. STANLEY KOWALSKI, a present member of the New Kensington police force, has offered reliable information regarding the MANNARINOS and he, too, is being considered for development as a PCI.
