LA 4268-C advised that he observed ROSSELLI at the Friar's Club, Beverly Hills, California on Tuesday, 8/4/64, and on Wednesday, 8/5/64. On 8/4/64, ROSSELLI was observed talking to MORRIS "MOE" GENSER, who is presently on trial for misconduct while he was an official of the Department of Motor Vehicles, State of California.

While talking to informant and BEN PLATT, ROSSELLI mentioned "my wife." BEN PLATT asked ROSSELLI if he had got married and ROSSELLI replied, "I slipped, forget it." PLATT then said that if ROSSELLI did get married, PLATT would like to sell his wife a fur coat. ROSSELLI said to forget it and added, "She's a millionaire and has more furs and jewels than you (PLATT) have."

ROSSELLI then told informant that he was waiting for AL PARVIN (contract furniture dealer and associate of numerous hoodlums). PARVIN arrived at about 5:45 p.m. and he and ROSSELLI began playing cards.

On 8/5/64, ROSSELLI arrived at the Friar's Club at about 4:45 p.m. and left at 5:00 p.m.
