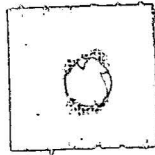
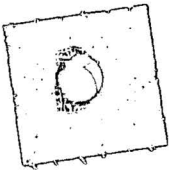

As the Bureau has been previously advised, ALBERTO SACCO, alleged brother of JOHN ROSELLI, traveled from Boston, Massachusetts to Los Angeles on 2/15/64, for the purpose of meeting LA 4448-C-TE and returned to Boston on the following day.

According to informant, ALBERTO SACCO stayed at a motel near the Los Angeles International Airport.

On 4/23/64, ROCK FAGOT, Manager, Ramada Inn, 9620 Airport Blvd., Los Angeles, California, Telephone No. OR 0-1600, was contacted by SA HAROLD F. DODGE and requested to search his files to determine if an ALBERTO SACCO was a guest at this Inn about 2/15/64.

Mr. FAGOT searched the registration cards and produced Registration Card No. 1408, which reflects that ALBERT SACCO, 46 Peirce Street, Arlington, Massachusetts, occupied Room 151, arriving at the hotel on 2/15/64 and leaving on 2/16/64. The registration card reflects there was only one person in the party and the rate charged was \$11.50. The back of the card bears two stamps, one dated 2/15/64, which apparently shows the time of arrival as 6:51 p.m. on that date and the other date is 2/16/64, which shows the apparent time of departure as 7:54 a.m.
