estate business due to the recent death of his partner-brother. In addition, it appears he has some reservations about testifying against ROSELLI, possibly due to the information set out in mytel that former CG 6498-C-TE advised his family is close to the PETRONE family. However, following his conversation with NISSON, EVANGELISTA realizes his only option is to travel to Los Angeles and testify and this he will do reluctantly. AUSA NISSON should be cautioned, however, that EVANGELISTA may not be a strong witness.

The problem presented by WELSH to NISSON involving the physical hardship involved in carrying two hundred pounds or so of records with him to Los Angeles. This was resolved by NISSON's approval of WELSH's suggestion that these records be shipped ahead which WELSH will do this date.

Both ANTHON and DEEVER suggested that they telephonically contact NISSON to determine whether they can submit certified copies of their records rather than travel to Los Angeles. This was not done in the presence of SA ROEMER but will probably be done this date. Both were advised that should NISSON approve this medhod, they should contact the Chicago Office which will insure that the certified copies or depositions, as the case may be, are forwarded to the Los Angeles Office prior to April 2 next.
