IS - CH 6MB 9-30-91 SLD IKSR Re New York letter and LHM 3/18/69. 10-11 FINDLEY HOWARD, head of Pan American World Airways for Mexico, Mexico City (protect by request), advised on May 9, 1969, that a review of passenger manifests for Pan American flight 551 which departed Mexico City on January 10, 1969, destined for Tampa and Miami with a stop at Merida, Yucatan, Mexico, failed to locate anyone on this flight named FRANK. Mr. HOWARD stated that if the subject boarded the flight at Merida the record would be located in Florida, not in Mexico City. He further noted that there was a group of six persons named DOYLE on that flight and two of the group were named FRANK and SUSAN. Mr. HOWARD advised that Pan American reservation information slips have been destroyed for that period. MEX 21 (MEX 137-3A-453) advised on June 4, 1969, that he had made checks concerning the activities of the subject and her husband in both Taxco and Mexico City and had been unable to locate any additional information concerning their activities in Mexico.
