## WEEKLY SUMMARY

The following is a summary of information furnished by PH 705-C\* during the period 9/19/64 through 9/24/64:

On 9/19/64 source provided only domestic activities regarding ROCCO SCAFIDI. Visitors came to the apartment but retired to the kitchen out of range of the source and furnished no intelligible information.

On 9/20/64 this activity was repeated.

On 9/21/64 ROGCO SCAFIDI was overheard telling an unknown person that on the previous Friday he had fallen off a truck at work and that his thigh was bruised. He could not go to work because of his injury. Source then called the Agent in Philadelphia and furnished the same information about the injury. SCAFIDI arranged for a doctor's appointment with his brother, SAM. SCAFIDI carried on a conversation in Sicilian that was not understandable to source with an unknown telephone caller. At 8:25 p.m. ROCCO SCAFIDI
