According to the article, the demonstrators flashed signs stating "Down with Batista," "Step the Bloodshed," and "Cuba, the Hungary of America." The article disclosed that Cesar Fonseca, one of the spokesmen for the group, stated that the demonstrators did not intend to march on the Cuban Consulate, which is some five blocks from the bust of Marti, but that the arrival of police caused the demonstrators to make a dash for the Consulate. police officers were knocked down and beaten by the demonstrators. One Alberto Blanco, 1019 Southwest 24th Road, possibly identical with the Blanco concerning whom you are inquiring, was among those booked by the Miami Police Department for their part in the demonstration.
