Enclosed for each of the offices receiving this communication is a copy of a report dated 11-13-58 received from a confidential source abroad on 11-28-58. (S)

In furnishing the enclosed data the confidential source abroad advised that the two persons believed to be Cubans who arrived in Cayman on 10-26-58, originally gave their names as Alberto Blanco and Antonio Guzman. The confidential source abroad added that subsequent to the publication of the attached report information was received that the correct names of these individuals are Alberto Crescencio de la Cruz Menendez and Oswaldo Antonio Castell y Valdes. The confidential source abroad advised the name of the third person in the plane is said to be Alberto but no other particulars concerning him are known. (S)

The confidential source abroad added that Mr. Stanley of the U.S. Customs in Miami already had the details of this matter. On 11-12-58, Mr. Stanley accompanied the Head of Jamaica Special Branch to Cayman to interview Charles Hormel. The data from the confidential source abroad was classified "Secret." (S)

Any pertinent information received concerning the activities of the individuals mentioned in the enclosure should be promptly furnished the Bureau.

In the event any of the information received from the confidential source abroad is incorporated in reports or otherwise disseminated, it should be appropriately paraphrased. (S)(U)

NOTE:

(S) [Stott on 11-28-58 furnished details of discovery of arms cache in Cayman, BWI, by the authorities there. The subjects and Charles William Hormel were involved. Hormel is subject of Customs case and Miami Customs official went to Cayman to interview Hormel.] Since all persons involved have Miami addresses, we are giving info to Miami with instructions to furnish us with any pertinent info, Miami may receive concerning the activities of the persons involved.
