### ADMINISTRATIVE

It is to be noted that Captain ALFREDO GUERRA Y AQUIAR, a relative of PEDRO LUIS DIAZ LANZ, FAR defector, is the source from whom Colonel ERICKSON NICHOLS, Air Attache, United States Embassy, Havana, apparently obtain his information upon which this case is predicated. GUERRA was formerly in the Intelligence Section of the Cuban Air Force. He is still known to be connected with the Cuban Government. As the communications received by this office from the Bureau do not precisely show that GUERRA was the Air Attache's source, the basis for this investion is being attributed to the Air Attache.

MM 635-S in addition to the information set forth in the body of instant report, advised that ARTURO FERNANDEZ DE CASTRO had recently furnished United States Customs some information concerning some B-25 and B-26 planes in the Miami area and claimed that United States Customs, on the basis of his information had agreed to detain these planes.

No dissemination of this report is being made to United States Customs locally and it is recommended that the Bureau not disseminate this report to United States Customs on the Washington level in order to afford adequate protection to MM 635-S.

It is felt that if United States Customs is in contact directly with ARTURO FERNANDEZ DE CASTRO concerning some matters that information might be inadvertently furnished to him through interrogation by United States Customs which would expose MM 635-S. (A.)

In 1959 U. S. Air Attache, Havana, Cuba, received information from a Cuban source to effect that ARTURO FERNANDEZ DE CASTRO, 6022 N. W. 5th Ave., Apt. 5, Miami, Fla., was in contact with the Intelligence Section of the Revolutionary Air Force, Cuba, for the purpose of keeping abreast of anti-revolutionary Cuban activities, in Miami area. In 1/60, MM T-1 advised that DE CASTRO is now working as an intelligence agent for EFIGENIO AMEIJEIRAS, Chief of the National Revolutionary Colice, Cuba, and is assigned to "Confidential A," a confidential intelligence section which has agents outside Cuba. In 1/60, DE CASTRO furnished AMEIJEIRAS with written report concerning his activities in Miami area and complained about not receiving money promptly from AMEIJEIRAS

## III. IMMIGRATION STATUS AND DESCRIPTION

On January 27, 1960, examination of Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) file A 8746061; reflected that ARTURO FLUTARCO FERNANDEZ DE CASTRO Y DIAZ, aka "BEBO", resided at 6022 N. W. 5th Avenue, Apartment 5, as of August 15, 1956. He formerly resided at 572 N. E. 67th Street, Apartment 2. His last permanent residence in Cuba was Primelles Number 320 Cerro, Havana, Cuba. He last entered the United States on October 7, 1955, at the Port of Miami. Prior to that, he entered the United States on September, 19, 1954, in possession of an 0-1 non-quota visa. He was in possession of Cuban Passport Number 25728, issued to him by the Cuban Ministry of State, Havana, on August 17, 1948.

His immigration file reflected the following descriptive data:

followers at the Biltmore Terrace Hotel, Miami Beach, had paid \$10,000.00 for several B-25 and B-26 planes in the Miami area.

MM T-1 said that in the middle of January, 1960, DE CASTRO prepared a report for AMEIJEIRAS enumerating the results of his investigations for AMEIJEIRAS, along with other appropriate comments. MM T-1 said that DE CASTRO disclosed that he uses the code name of FIDELIS SANCHEZ in submitting reports to AMEIJEIRAS.

According to MM T-1, DE CASTRO complained to AMEIJEIRAS about not receiving money promptly from AMEIJEIRAS in return for his services and he was financially hardpressed. He also complained about his method of communicating information to AMEIJEIRAS is bad and that there should be some more direct method agreed upon. He advised that he suggested that a person in Havana be named to receive both mail and telephone calls from him.

DE CASTRO disclosed that he had been in contact with CARMEN QUINTANA, a woman who had been sent to Miami on a mission on or about December 27, 1959. He disclosed that this woman left Miami on December 28, 1959, and that he himself had aided her financially, but had received no further word from her.

DE CASTRO reported that he felt sure that there would not be an invasion or air attack against Cuba during the month of January. He disclosed that he had sent AMEIJEIRAS a report during the previous week and inquired as to whether or not it had been received.

He inquired as to whether or not a Lieutenant PALMERO used to be in "Confidential A" and whether or not AMEIJEIRAS had received the reports which he, DE CASTRO, had sent to PALMERO.
