On 2/23/60, Gen. JOSE E. PEDRAZA arrived in the U. S. with MANUEL PEREZ SOSA of the Dominican Republic. (DR) PEDRAZA visited NYC and Washington, D. C., where he conferred with FRANCISCO CAJIGAS and CARLOS MARQUEZ STERLING. PEDRAZA said he has about 100 men in DR and presumes Gen. TRUJILLO feels he has some control over PEDRAZA's group. PEDRAZA decided on CAJIGAS as political leader of anti-CASTRO movement and received pledges of support from anti-CASTRO organizations. Leading Cuban political figures in Miami stated PEDRAZA in constant company of PEREZ SOSA; which was interpreted as DR control of anti-CASTRO movement. PEDRAZA denied being under DR influence, and said he was in Miami to determine strength of movement for future utilization. On 3/17/60, US Department of Justice intended to solicit registration of PEDRAZA under Foreign Agents Registration Act of 1938, as amended. [On 3/21/60, Cuban Government planned to request extradition of PEDRAZA.] On 3/23/60, PEDRAZA returned to DR. Some leading Cuban figures said CAJIGAS was not acceptable as political leader of movement. On 3/17/60, some 20 Cuban leaders reportedly met and accepted CAJIGAS as political leader. NUNEZ PORTUONDO said he wanted no active part and was not for or against unified movement. MARQUEZ STERLING said he should be named Provisional President. Some political leaders think MARQUEZ would be promoted by FULGENCIO BATISTA as political head of movement. PEDRAZA was to go to Nicaragua on 4/27 or 28/60, concerning formation of a base in Nicaragua.
