A copy of the ticket reflected it had been utilized on the above-mentioned date.

NY T-1, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised Frank apparently had been in Los Angeles, California, on or around September 17 and 22, 1971, and was probably lodged at the Sheraton Inn of Los Angeles on September 17, and at the Chateau Marmont Hotel on September 22, 1971.

NY T-2, a confidential source abroad, advised Frank entered the People's Republic of China on September 29, 1971.
