2. The subscriber of telephone 635-3244 is  
York University, Toronto. The telephone services the  
office of James Alexander BEVERIDGE, Director for  
Programme in Film. BEVERIDGE resided in Rawleigh,  
North Carolina from October 1962 to July 1965 where  
he was employed with the North Carolina Film Board.  
He was again a resident of the United States in 1967  
at 4 Rustic Lane, Green Farms, Conn. Our records  
reveal no adverse information regarding BEVERIDGE.

3. The telephone number 234-8424 is listed  
to the New China News Agency in Ottawa.

4. It has been learned that the number  
Z464699297 is a "Batch" number used for computer  
purposes and records are maintained for a sixty-day  
period only, after which a new series is started.  
Therefore, the records for this number are not  
available.
