Vice Consul ERNEST HOLM, American Consulate, Veracruz, Veracruz, Mexico, advised on 1/23-24/64 that the subject formerly spent a great deal of his time while in Veracruz at the Cafe Fleu de Lis in central Veracruz. HARBER has not been seen in Veracruz in recent weeks and Consul HOLM was unable to furnish any information concerning his possible whereabouts.

HOLM agreed to advise Legat, Mexico, immediately if any information does come to his attention concerning the activities or whereabouts of subject.

MEX-180 advised on 2/11/64 that he had been unable to locate any information identifiable with the subject in the files of the Mexican Department of Immigration.

Information copies of this letter are being furnished to Miami and New York in view of their continuing interest in the subject.
