John Pittman mentioned above is possibly identical with John Pittman who has been the subject of an investigation by this Bureau. In connection with our investigation of Pittman, a copy of the report of Special Agent Thernton M. Wood dated October 16, 1953, at New York, New York, captioned "John Pitthan, Internal Security - C," was furnished to the Atomic Energy Commission on April 27, 1954, through Lisison channels. It is observed that as of October, 1953, Pittman was employed as Foreign Editor for the "Daily Worker" and "The Worker," having been so employed since April 24, 1951. He was previously Associate Editor of the "Daily Worker" and "The Worker." [He reportedly attended a meeting in Europe in [5. 1946 with William 2. Foster and French Communist leaders. An alleged Comintern representative also reportedly attended this meeting.] Pittman attended the 1950 convention of the Communist Party held in December, 1950, at New York City and he was elected to the convention's Press Committee. In September, 1951, Pittman covered the San Francisco Japanese Peace Treaty Conference for the "Daily Worker" and the "Daily People's World." He has been an instructor for the Jefferson School of Social Science since 1949 and has written for the publications "People's Voice," "Jewish Life," and "Masses and Mainstream." He has been a speaker at Communist Party meetings.

In view of Pittman's close Communist affiliations over a period of years and his present employment with the "Daily Worker," there appears to be no reason to believe he would be cooperative. An interview with him at this time is not contemplated.
