ReRomelet 4/18/63 which advised Rome Office was rechecking with Italian Police to verify the dates subject lodged at the Hotel di Prima in Caltanissetta, Sicily. (c)

On April 22, 1963, Dr. Baldesar, Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, advised that he had rechecked with Italian Police in Caltanissetta and was informed that subject and his wife, Assunta, had checked out of the Hotel di Prima at 12:00 noon on March 31, 1963. He further ascertained subject and his wife left in an unidentified automobile for Germany and were then scheduled to leave by plane for Florida from Germany. (c)

On April 24, 1963, Dr. Baldesar called the Rome Office and advised that Italian Police had ascertained subject as of April 3, 1963, was lodged at the Hotel Excelsior in Naples, Italy, and on April 6, 1963, left by auto for Pescara, Italy. (c)

Rome Office has requested Dr. Baldesar to continue efforts to determine details of subject's travels and activities in Italy and as soon as further information is received Bureau and interested offices will be promptly advised. (c)
